Innovation cluster as an organic element of the national economy

The article researches the essence of the innovation cluster and identifies its characteristic features. The urgent need for the development of innovative clusters and their organic inclusion in the national economy is proved. The attention is focused on the fact that in the process of state regulation, it is important to recombine liberal and conducting cluster policies, taking into account the domestic model of the innovation environment. A pyramid of basic priorities of state policy for supporting innovation clusters has been developed.
