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EDUCATIONAL INNOVATION: CONCEPTS, CLASSIFICATION, ANALYSIS

The article studies the need for the development and implementation of innovations in the educational sphere due, primarily, to the need to improve the quality and effectiveness of education, train qualified specialists for all sectors of the national economy and increase the level of development, competitiveness, prestige of the country and its national security. In the research process, methods of analytical processing of scientific works, as well as analysis and synthesis were used to clarify the concept of "educational innovation"; analysis of time series and relative values to analyze the state of the educational sphere and the quality of the passage of innovative processes in it. It is, in the educational sphere, the main innovative developments are carried out. However, in recent years, this process has slowed down for a number of reasons. To create a database of data necessary for a detailed wide analysis of innovative processes, it is required to improve statistical reporting. Improving the educational process, including through innovation, contribute to strengthening the national and educational security of the country. The results obtained can serve as a basis for further studies of the educational sphere, innovations in education and educational safety.

Conclusions. Enterprises that develop and implement educational innovations should remember that in order to increase the effectiveness of these processes, the following steps should be followed: creating innovations, analyzing educational activities and identifying problematic issues, designing, testing and examining innovations); distribution of innovations (preparatory stage, information campaign, support for innovation, marketing analysis of the market and the results of innovation); mastering innovations (analysis of the educational system, the search for innovations, an alternative analysis of existing innovations, designing promising educational activities, introducing innovations, evaluating the results of changes, institutionalizing innovations); educational process.
