THE PHENOMENON OF "AUTARKY OF LARGE SPACES" FRIEDRICH LISZT AND UKRAINE

The article is devoted to the study of the economic model of "soft" autarky with the policy of economic protectionism, in connection with the need to develop and implement qualitatively new priorities of Ukraine's economic strategy aimed at national security, in particular by preserving structural imbalances and stagnation of the national economy.

The aim is to analyze the economic model of the founder of autarky, Friedrich Liszt. Outline the components of the economic model of "soft" autarky with the policy of economic protectionism as part of the economic security policy of Ukraine. To determine the conditions of application of this theory on the territory of Ukraine.

Using the model of "soft" autarky with the policy of economic protectionism as the basis of the economic model of autarky, would make it possible to oppose both unbridled liberalism and restoration projects of neo-communists who do not want to seriously correct dogmas that have become obsolete and ineffective. The very fact of putting forward Liszt's theory in the context of the current economic situation in Ukraine would be a great achievement, because here one can find answers to the most pressing questions and at the same time put an end to the stalemate dualism of "reformers and anti-reformers." Moreover, the positive aspects of the liberal transformations left over from socialism could be perfectly involved in this economic project. But all this will have a positive effect only in the context of a conscious and theoretically elaborated doctrinal corpus, and not as pragmatic moves carried out from case to case. This project must have its unambiguous political expression. Any inertial centrism, pragmatism and compromise will be deliberately doomed.
